Get ready to experience the Bible in a new way. First, use your imagination! Imagine what it was like to live in the ancient city of Babylon. Now, think of Daniel and his friends, as captives, being forced to move to Babylon. What would it be like to be torn from everything and everyone you knew and loved? In this foreign land, in preparation for service to the king, Daniel had to learn a new language, eat new food, learn new complicated subjects and worship new gods. Or would he? Our adventures in Babylon will show us Daniel did not try to fit in. He stood firm in his faith and belief of the one true God. Daniel's courage to remain true to God, has served as an example and encouragement to Christians for thousands of years.

At Old Providence Vacation Bible School (VBS), our mission will be to study the scriptures and learn about Daniel and his faith. This year, VBS will not have typical classrooms; instead, groups of all ages will travel together in tribes. There will be 12 tribes, (the 12 tribes of Israel) with lessons by the tribe leaders each day. Traveling together, adults, youth and children, of all ages, will experience the culture of ancient Babylon. They will explore the Marketplace, visit Daniel in his palace room and dig into scripture. The tribes will take part in games at the Palace Playground, taste foods of the period and enjoy songs and crafts.
