And the promise made to those who trust in Him is the promise of life eternal. God's Word continues in I Corinthians 15: 20-22 by saying "But as it is, Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep. For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead also comes through a man. For just as in Adam all die, so also in Christ all will be made alive." Let these words encourage you as you consider Christ's sacrifice and glory. Also, let these truths encourage you to commit anew to being a regular part of the life at Old Providence, and certainly plan to worship with us this Easter.
