Dear Old Providence Family,

What does it mean to be the Church? This question, though simple at first glance, is based on an assumption. Namely, that "the Church" is far more than buildings dedicated as places of worship. Much to the contrary, it is the people of God that are the Church. Every Lord's Day we confess in saying the Apostles' Creed that we believe in the "Holy Christian Church". Furthermore, we know that the promises of God are true, including Jesus' own promise in Matthew 16:18 to build His Church. But again, when it comes right down to it, what does it mean to be the Church?

God's Word is not silent on this issue. In his Sermon on the Mount in Matthew 5:14-16, Jesus said <sup>14</sup> "You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. <sup>15</sup> Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. <sup>16</sup> In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven. What is revealed in this passage about what it means to be the Church, is both encouraging and convicting.

First, the people of God should be encouraged by Jesus' words. After all, we are called the light of the world! God has given us the grand responsibility and privilege to be His ambassadors to a dark world, in desperate need of salvation. But second, Jesus' words ought also to convict us. It is because we are light that we are given the responsibility to shine forth into darkness so that the world may see our faith as genuine, pointing to the glory of God. With these things in mind, and the grand call to point others to Christ, let us move forward together, always remembering that we are the Church, and that we have much work to do.

#### **Bus Trip**

The Spiritual Care Committee has been working hard to find the most cost effective trip to the Ark Encounter in Williamstown, KY and the Creation Museum in Petersburg, KY. We have scheduled this bus trip for October  $10^{th} - 12^{th}$ . The bus will be leaving on Thursday from Old Providence at 7:30 a.m. and return on Saturday at 9:30 p.m. We will be going to the Ark on Friday and to the Creation Museum on Saturday morning.

The following rates are based on 30 people. If we have 40 seats filled, then the cost will be reduced some. Rates are:

Single - \$499.00 - (one person in a room)

Double - \$380.00 - (two persons in one room)

Triple - \$341.00 - (three persons in one room)

Quad - \$321.00 - (four persons in one room)

These prices include transportation, 2 nights lodging, 2 breakfast buffets, 2 dinners, admission to both museums, baggage handling for 1 bag per person, and all taxes and gratuities on these items. We are requesting \$100.00 deposit when you sign up with the final payment being made by August 28<sup>th</sup>. We are giving Old Providence members until August 5<sup>th</sup> to sign up and then we will open it to the community. You can sign up with Martha or Linda. They will in turn give the money to Randy who will serve as the Treasurer for this trip.
