Homecoming and Special Services

Please join us for our Homecoming Service on Sunday, August 28th at 10:00 a.m. We will observe the Sacrament of the Lord's Supper, and Children's Church will meet. There will be a covered dish meal immediately following the Worship Service. We will not meet for Sabbath School. Special Services will be held each evening at 7:00 on Sunday, August 28th – Wednesday, August 31st with an Ice Cream Social after the Wednesday night service.

Our guest speaker on Sunday and Monday will be Mr. Alex Pettett. Alex has served for 11 years in missions in the middle east working with refugees and church planting. His life in ministry also included five years of youth ministry at First ARP Church, Gastonia, NC. Alex has been the Executive Director of the ARP Mission Agency, World Witness since January 2014 and completed his M.Div. at Erskine Seminary in 2021. Alex's wife, Jamie, is originally from Illinois where she did BA studies at the University of Illinois in the subject of Islam. They met in Amman, Jordan in 1999 as Alex was completing an M.A. in Judaic studies at Hebrew University. They have been married for 21 years and have three children.

On Tuesday and Wednesday our guest speaker will be Rev. Lee Shelnutt who began serving with World Witness full-time in June as the Team Leader for a new ministry/field called the Barnabas Ministry. The Barnabas Ministry is a ministry of pastoral and leadership training and discipleship in two countries -- Pakistan and Rwanda. In addition to the work in Pakistan and Rwanda, he will serve as an encourager, facilitator, and coordinator for many of our World Witness missionaries in Europe and give oversight for our school ministries in Pakistan. Before coming onboard with World Witness full-time, Lee served as the Senior Pastor at Huntersville ARP Church, in Huntersville, NC, where he pastored from 2011 to 2022. He was ordained to gospel ministry in 1997 and served first as the church planter and then pastor of the Westminster ARP congregation in Albemarle, NC. He is a former moderator of the General Synod and has served in various capacities throughout the ARP denomination, including present service on the Erskine Board of Trustees. He is a graduate of Reformed Theological Seminary - Charlotte, the Atlanta School of Biblical Studies, and Georgia Tech. He has worked in the engineering field with Delta Air Lines. Lee and his wife, Joni, have one daughter.
