Dear Old Providence Family,

Maybe you've heard it already, but if not, let me be the first to say, "Merry Christmas!" Advent, that time when we celebrate God sending his one and only Son, is upon us. I wonder how you are approaching this Advent season. Is it a surprise that 2022 is almost over? This past year sure seems to have gone by quickly. Are you entering the Christmas season with great joy and happiness? Many wonderful things have happened over this past year. Couples have been married, others have welcomed new children (which means new grandchildren, too), and maybe situations in your life have improved or you are simply enjoying what the Lord has done for you.

But, at the same time, I recognize that the Christmas season can also be difficult. The holidays can serve as a reminder of the way we think things ought to be. Christmas, particularly, can dredge up memories from the past. Some of these memories may be good, and some not so good. There's no doubt about it, the holidays are an emotionally charged time of year. But no matter what you are facing or what you've been through, whether you are in a time of great joy or a time of sadness, let me encourage you to focus on God's love this Advent season.

There are many ways to focus on God's love but allow me to suggest a few. First, consider changing your normal time in God's Word to include passages that focus on Christmas, like Isaiah chapter 9 or 52. Second, as you go to the Lord in prayer, spend some time reflecting on His great love for you and thank Him for sending His only begotten Son. Third, if you are able, make the commitment to be in church. I am excited about our coming Christmas sermon series on the Advent of our Lord, and I believe it will be a blessing to you. Fourth, participate in the life of the church throughout the Christmas season. We will be having special programs for Christmas that will point you to God's Love and will provide excellent opportunities for fellowship with one another. Christmas even falls on the Lord's Day this year! So, make it a point to be at church on Christmas Sunday. Our worship service will focus on singing Christmas carols and the sermon will even be short (and I really mean it!).

While we celebrate Christ throughout the year, it is at Christmas that we focus on the fact that God drew near to us while we were still at enmity with Him. God the Son took on flesh and made his dwelling among us. As John 1 says, Jesus came as the Light of the World. We are called to be people of the Light, reflecting the glory and majesty of Jesus Christ. As Christmas steadily approaches, make sure that your focus is on Jesus Christ, the greatest gift of all. And as you plan your Christmas activities, make sure that you remember the Lord first, and that you testify to His greatness.
