All such boasting is evil. Here, God's Word reminds us of both the brevity of life and the scope of our knowledge. We need the Lord! It's just that simple. As James wrote, if we were to proceed into the future as if we were the masters of our own destiny, with no regard for God, we become evil boasters. Instead, as verse 15 says, our focus should be on God and our desire should be for His will to be done.

As you enter 2023, do so with the full assurance that God will be with you no matter what you face. Hold on to the promise Jesus made in Matthew 28:20 when He said, "I am with you always, to the end of the age." And remember, the only way to really have a "Happy New Year" is to rejoice in Christ. If you make New Year's resolutions, make sure that you are seeking God's will and relying on His strength alone to do what it is you have set out to accomplish.
