IN THE NEWS "SPOTLIGHT ON CHURCH HISTORY"

The history of the artifacts in the sanctuary of Old Providence becomes more of interest as we begin to celebrate the centennial of the building of our present church.

Time-line of the building of the sanctuary:

- 1916 The congregation approved a joint report from the elders, deacons, and trustees that a new church be built on the "old school house lot".
- 1917 The building committee received the complete set of blueprints for the building. Actual construction begins.
- 1918 Construction continues throughout the year.
- 1919 Carpentry work "about" completed.
- 11-2-19 First service in the new church.

Sanctuary Artifacts:

- Communion Table Built by Irvin Rosen in 1961, refinished by Jerry Rosen in 2000
- Baptismal Font Given by the wife and daughters of Warren Ashton Rowan, who served as elder for 53 years
- McCormick Window In memory of the Cyrus Hall McCormick family (large window on the west side of the building)

The three Pulpit chairs – Believed to be from the "Old Brick Church"

Display Cabinet – Built by Irvin Rosen and contains historical artifacts


