Dear Old Providence Family,

I think the word "opportunity" is rather interesting and challenging. If you google "opportunity" or retrieve your handy dictionary and look it up, you'll find that "opportunity" is defined as "a set of circumstances that makes it possible to do something."

Consider the first part of this definition, that opportunity begins with "a set of circumstances." I find this interesting because the world is wide open as to the opportunities that God provides through the circumstances we face. We are always given the opportunity to follow God's Word and will, no matter what. We are also given the opportunity to testify to His greatness and the wonder of our Lord, Jesus Christ. And we dare not forget the opportunity God gives us to pray on all occasions, as Ephesians 6 says. All of this is wonderfully interesting because we never know what circumstances God will bring our way in order to do these things. How wonderful and exciting it is that God allows us to be a part of His grand redemptive plan for His people!

I fear that far too often we miss the opportunities God gives us. Take, for instance, the opportunities we have to engage in evangelism and support missions. The world is full of lost people who have no hope. As Jesus had compassion on those who were like sheep without shepherds, we should have compassion on those who do not know Him. The only remedy for this situation, of course, is to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ. Yet, when we do not take advantage of the opportunity to either directly share the truth of Christ or support those who do, the opportunity to do God's will simply passes by.

We need not fool ourselves. If we refuse to act on God's opportunities, He will give those opportunities to those who will act. Instead, let us pursue God's glory. Let us focus our hearts and intentions on the gospel of Jesus Christ. And, as a result, let us take the opportunities God brings our way. God has blessed us in so many ways. Let us be a blessing to Him.
